



GREATER MICHIGAN CONSTRUCTION ACADEMY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Academic Criteria

1. Applicant must be receiving a high school diploma or GED in 2023 or have received a high school diploma or GED in the current, or within one academic year of attending.
2. GPA and high school attendance will be used as applicant evaluation criteria.
3. Applicant must have official copies of high school or GED transcripts and attendance report submitted to Greater Michigan Construction Academy (GMCA).
4. Applicant must be pursuing post-secondary education and training in a skilled trades program
5. Scholarship must be used to attend GMCA for one of the specific Craft training programs being offered at time of enrollment.
6. Scholarships will be awarded to students who may or may not have financial needs.
7. Recipient of scholarship(s) must adhere to all GMCA Policies and Procedures. Failure to do so will result in a loss of scholarship.
8. Award is restricted to one year and must be used in the academic year following the announcement of the recipient.
9. Applicant will be evaluated in the following areas: desire to pursue a trade, GPA/GED, work/life skills, high school attendance records, honors/awards, and extracurricular activities.
10. OPTIONAL: Up to two (2) references will be considered in the selection process. Links to the references are available under the Registration/Scholarship tab at www.gmcami.org, or by calling 989-832-8879.
11. Applicant must submit a completed application through the scholarship application link at gmcami.org.
12. All materials required for this scholarship (application form, transcripts, reference forms) must be received by GMCA by **no later than 5:00pm, THURSDAY, MARCH 7, 2024**. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.
